From the George Washington Bridge

1. Take 95 South to 78.
2. Take 78 West about 28 miles.
3. Exit at Route 287 South
4. Proceed about 3 miles.
5. Take the Somerville Exit, Route 202 South. Do not take any of the other 202 exits, 202 runs parallel to 287.
6. Continue on 202 south about 20 miles to the Pennsylvania border, the Delaware River. You will pass through Flemington and past Lambertville.
7. Just after the toll booth on the Pennsylvania side of the bridge, take the first exit to the right into New Hope.
8. From the light in New Hope (Bridge St & Main), continue straight, south on Main Street (bridge/river will be to your left).
9. Proceed about half mile until you reach the edge of town and cross the Canal.
10. As you leave town, take the second right up the hill on 232 South (known locally as Windybush).
11. Proceed about 1 mile.
12. Turn left on Aquetong Road.
13. Proceed about half mile.
14. We are on the right. We have a small wooden sign "Nakashima" and two black mailboxes, numbered 1847.
15. You may park near the low stone wall near the shop or to the right close to the road. Please do not park in the turnaround circle.
16. We also have a second gate between the Main Shop and Finishing Room. Parking is available around the bend. Our Office is in the "Showroom," the small fieldstone building behind the main shop, next to the low Japanese Cut-Leaf Maple.
